



Energy Partnership – Energy Data Release Form

Bridgewater-based members of the Energy Partnership, as well as other community business and organizations that support the Energize Bridgewater initiative, are kindly requested to provide information on the energy consumption of their facilities and vehicles. Your business or organization's involvement in this project is important to its overall success. By submitting this completed Energy Data Release Form, your business or organization agrees to supply information ("Data") to the Town of Bridgewater ("Town") for the following purpose ("Purpose"): **to compile energy baseline information that will help create the Town's Community Energy Investment Plan, and related documents.**

In releasing this Data and permitting its usage, your business or organization and the Town agree to the following terms:

1. **Proprietary Rights:** your business or organization is the owner of the Data originally supplied only. Any modifications, additions, or amendments is the property of the Town for the Community Energy Investment Plan.
2. **Limitations to Use of Data:** your business or organization grants the Town permission to use the Data for the Purpose described above. Any report prepared by or on behalf of the Town may reproduce the Data only in a form which aggregates your Data with that of other businesses and organizations, such that the Data becomes non-identifying. The Town may not sell, license or otherwise commercially exploit the Data for profit.
3. **Use of Data by Third Parties:** The Town may permit third parties to use the Data only on behalf of the Town and only for the Purpose described above. The Town must obtain from such third parties an agreement that they are bound by the same terms described here.
4. **No Warranties:** The Data provided by you is on an "as is" and "as available" basis. The Town's use of the Data is solely at its own risk.
5. **Limitation of Liability:** Under no circumstances shall your business or organization, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or representatives, be liable for the use of or reliance on the Data.

6. **Term and Termination:** These terms and the Town’s rights to the Data may be terminated by your business or organization upon providing written notice to the Town. Upon termination of the agreement, the Town agrees, within 90 days, to refrain from further use of the Data originally supplied by you, and to delete copies of same, using commercially reasonable means to do so.
